



## **Fuel Testing Procedures**

- 1. After all approved procedures for fuel testing (Article 9 Section 3 in QMA rule book) have been checked and fuel additives are suspected, a sample of the fuel in an approved sample bottle is required. The approved bottle must be sealed immediately and sent to the National Tech Director in the next 24 hours for laboratory testing.**
- 2. You will also need a sample of your base line fuel in an approved sample bottle, which also needs to be sealed immediately, and sent with the suspicious fuel sample to the National Tech Director in the next 24 hours for laboratory testing.**
- 3. If laboratory results confirm that the fuel has additives or is illegal penalties under number 10, section 3, Article in the QMA rulebook should be followed. Handler will also be held responsible for cost of laboratory testing if fuel is found to be illegal.**
