IMPORTANT ITEMS BELOW:

1. Club application for a Non-Racing Charter will be processed to reflect a club's commitment to secure land for a new track or to substantiate a club's existence while obtaining property from and/or arrangement agreements with local governmental authorities.
2. The cost of a Non-Racing Club Charter is \$100.00 for one calendar year and is nonrefundable. No additional charge will be assessed when a Racing Charter is issued in the same year.
3. At least 5 members from the new club must join QMA. These individuals will more than likely be members of other clubs and will have to pay dues to both clubs during the start-up of the new club.
4. The Non-Racing Charter is temporary and will require no insurance payment. NOTE: There is NO INSURANCE COVERAGE until the club's track is complete and racing begins.
5. All members of this Non-Racing Club, it properties and assets will be uninsured through any QMA carrier until the full racing charter is issued. Construction insurance and any required additional liability insurance is the responsibility of the club.
6. Clubs must submit a blueprint/drawing of their track layout prior to beginning construction for approval by the QMA National Safety Director and copies to QMA National Vice President and final approval from the QMA National Board of Directors. This must be done prior to obtaining your QMA non racing charter.
7. By the club officers signatures below, your club acknowledges and agrees to the QMA Rules and Regulations printed in the latest QMA Rulebook, as well as any and all rules and regulations updates that have been approved and placed in print since the last publication of the QMA Rulebook; this also includes any and all technical procedures established by QMA.
8. As all QMA Club's By-law's must be in accordance with QMA's by laws, you must send to the QMA National Vice President your Club Rules, Racing Procedures (including QMA Code of Conduct) and Racing Rules/format that apply at your club. Your club will not be issued a Non Racing Charter until your blue prints/drawing and rules have been approved by the National Safety Director & National Vice President with final approval from the National Board of Director's.
9. Submit a current listing of your club officers along with this completed form, with your payment to QMA National Vice President.
