

PARENTAL CONSENT, RELEASE & WAIVER FOR DRIVER(S) RACING WITHOUT PARENTS PRESENT

When a driver arrives to sign in at a track with a handler who is not the parent/guardian, the following is necessary to have on file:

- The K&K "Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement" form signed by both parents and child. <u>It MUST be</u> <u>NOTARIZED</u> as proof of parents' signatures.
- 2) A letter from the parents stating that it is okay for their child to race and who the handler will be. Attach this letter to the above Waiver form.

EXAMPLE:

I give my permission for my child (CHILD'S NAME) to race at (TRACK NAME OR EVENT, i.e. 2008 Eastern Grands) under the supervision of (HANDLER'S NAME).
