RACING CHARTER

Racing Charter:

A Racing Charter is just what it states, an existing club that renews yearly, with previous rules, by laws and schedule on file (must be a permanent track and comply with QMA Rules and Regulations). The clubs can make a few revisions year to year to their by-laws, rules, etc. with their Regional Director's approval, Vice President of QMA Approval and final approval from the National Board of Directors.

A new Racing Charter is a new club that has had their blueprints approved from their Regional Director and National Safety Director. (Track must be permanent and comply with QMA Rules and Regulations). Along with the blueprints being approved, they must also have their rules, by laws and schedule approved (must comply with QMA rules and regulations) by their Regional Director, Vice President of QMA and final approval from the National Board of Directors.

A club with a Racing Charter that has lost their track or property will become eligible to obtain a Non Racing charter for one year. They must follow all Non Racing Charter Procedures.
