



ELECTION PROCEDURES

Resumes must be submitted to the QMA National Secretary by September 15th of the election year.

Candidates **MUST** be a Regular QMA member in good standing and dues paid for the next year in order to run.

Candidates **MUST** also meet the following requirements:

1. Have been a member of the Corporation in good standing for two consecutive years;
2. Have served on one of the Corporation's Club boards governing bodies;
3. Not concurrently serve on the board of any competing Quarter Midget association and
4. Not be a vendor engaged in the repair, manufacturing or sale of Quarter Midget cars or Quarter Midget car parts.

QMA Board position requirements may be reviewed for consideration depending on special circumstances. All resumes for both National elections can be viewed electronically via the QMA website www.quartermidgets.org through October 3. Paper ballots will be available upon request.

It is the responsibility of the Election Committee (which will consist of 3 non-running National Board Members and 3 Club Presidents) to provide instructions and means for electronic voting to each regular member in good standing by way of an Independent Third Party vendor established for the purpose of holding elections.

The Election Committee will verify the National master mailing list and furnish it to the Independent Third Party to use to verify and count votes. The Independent Third Party must provide the passwords/codes for electronic voting.

The Election Committee is to receive the results from the Independent Third Party and furnish a final report to the National Board.

Results will be published Nov 15th via the QMA web site and the QMA newsletter.
